Niels-Erik Brokopp joined the European Court of Auditors in 1992. Since 2014, he is a Principal Manager in Chamber II primarily responsible for performance audits within the area of Investment for cohesion, growth and inclusion. He was head of unit for 'Audit Supervision and support' for financial and compliance audit from 2008 to 2014 during which time he also took part in the revision of the ISSAI Fundamental Auditing Principles. Prior to taking up this position, he worked as auditor in the coordination unit for SoA from 2007 to 2008, in the 'Administrative and other expenditure' unit from 2004 to 2007 and in the 'ERDF, CF, tourism and transport' unit from 1992 to 2004.

Before joining the Court, Niels-Erik Brokopp worked as an audit manager and auditor in KPMG Copenhagen from 1986 to 1992. At Copenhagen Business School he studied financial and management accounting and obtained a master degree in business economics and auditing.
